

Technical Guidelines for E-poster Presentation

All e-posters will be available on the Congress Virtual Platform during the Congress. Please read the following guidelines carefully before preparing your e-poster:

Poster Guidelines

Template

Please only use the Official E-Poster Template to prepare your e-poster.

Format

- File Format: PDF (.pdf)
- Printed posters or photographs of printed posters will NOT be accepted

Poster Size

- Pixels: 1920 (Width) x 1080 (Height), HD
- Ratio of Display Screen: 16:9
- Layout: Landscape (Horizontal orientation), **maximum 3 slides**

Language

- Text should be in ENGLISH only.

Poster Title

- The title should be displayed at the top of the poster, in the lettering of **18 Bold (Times New Roman)**, and include the following information: Name(s) of the Author(s) and Affiliation(s).
- It is recommended to **keep the title of the poster same** as in the submitted abstract. Slight modification which does not change the idea of the abstract is also allowed.

Poster Content

- The content should contain the study **content as follows**:
 - Scientific Abstract: Objective, Materials & Methods, Results, Conclusion
 - Case Report: Introduction, Clinical Report, Discussion
 - Educational Posters: Introduction, Teaching Points
- It is recommended to use **14 Times New Roman** font style for the content of the poster.
- Please use both UPPER and lower case letters for general content, as all-capital text is difficult to read.
- Avoid the use of full sentences and rather use short text in bullet point format.
- Avoid using watermarks that may detract from the readability of your poster.

Illustrations

- Illustrations are the most important part of the poster and will attract the most attention. Explanatory illustrations should be used instead of text whenever possible.
- **Static images/photos, graphs and tables can be included in the e-poster. Hyperlinks, video files and animations are not permitted and will be non-functioning.**
- QR codes may be included as part of your poster to direct viewers to a download of your poster.
- Try to utilise the space on your poster as creatively as you can to attract the audience and make sure that the images are easy to understand.
- Illustrations should be professionally drawn. Hand-drawn material will not be accepted.

Poster Submission

Please save your file name of e-poster as follows and upload the file to the dropbox link:

- **Paper Number_Last Name.pdf** (e.g.: 027_Smith.pdf)

The [Dropbox Submission Portal](#) will be closed on **30 May 2022 at 11:59pm (Hong Kong Time, GMT+8)**. Please note that changes on all the files are not allowed after the submission deadline.
